- Staffing Update
 - o The Care Center continues to struggle with staffing of Nursing Assistants



- We have hired a FT Registered Nurse; the Nurse Manager will begin training when the RN is fully trained.

- Census as of 11/23/2021:
 - o Acute: 3
 - o Care Center: 25
 - o Emergency Room: 3
- We are currently working through the vaccine mandate and exemptions for those staff who are not vaccinated.
- Turkey certificates have been presented to staff and mailed out to board members.
- Senior Leadership met with Russ White to discuss the strategic planning sessions and chose two areas to focus on, meetings will continue in January.
- Union Negotiations are taking place with AFSCME Support and Tech. MNA negotiations will start in December.
- Governor Walz has announced he will be providing financial support to Nursing Homes as well as Nursing Assistant training the National Guard to provide help to facilities in need.
- The American Rescue Plan has announced they hope to provide funds to facilities for hazard pay and to help hire vaccinated employees.

- a) COVID Update Julie Lesemann
 - Booster doses-now approved for everyone 18+
 - Staffing shortage help from state-500 national guard troops are receiving CNA training this week to help with staffing shortages in LTC facilities. Previously, a facility had to have an outbreak of COVID for the help to be requested. This is not the case for this help.
 - NE Coalition-Nichole is joining a committee that is being formed to talk about diversion. This will give smaller hospitals a voice on this topic. The first meeting is next week.
 - Nichole states that it is possible that FEMA may be deployed to each region in the state to help with administered monoclonal therapies.
 - The Care Center cannot restrict visitation at this time.
 - We are testing LTC staff twice weekly.

- There will now be either a lottery system or scoring system to determine who receives the monoclonal treatment. Just because someone comes to the ER and needs it doesn't guarantee they will be able to get it.
- Last week there were 6000 requests for monoclonal and only 2400 doses available.
- We do not have any supply shortages and no services affected in the past week.
- Emergency Operations Center is still active until further notice.
